Classroom Focus

RECEPTION



This half term our focus is on Light and Dark which will include celebrating Christmas. As part of this theme, this week we are thinking about owls. We are finding out lots of interesting facts about where they live and what they do. We enjoyed sharing the book Owl Babies together in Drawing Club. Every week in Drawing Club we explore some exciting new words inspired by the week's story, then we read and talk about the book together. Next, we each draw a picture based on something that happens in the book but with a special twist. When a 'code word' is added to the picture, something amazing happens! This week we drew Bill the owl making his wish. When we've

written the code and someone reads it, Bill gets his wish. We thought he might like owl hot chocolate

made from chocolate worms and spiders!

In Outdoor Learning the children have been comparing the photos of trees and plants they took last half term with the same view now. Mrs Miles has been very impressed with their knowledge of the changes the season of Autumn brings.

We are also learning to feel really confident recognising numbers 1 – 10 and making sure that we know how to count out a matching number of objects .

There's still plenty of time for experimenting with different building materials, writing and making music as we learn.
