

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Classroom Focus

YEAR ONE





As we are approach Christmas we will be exploring key characters in the Christmas story, making inferences about their character and using what we discuss to write speech bubbles to show what they might say at different points in the story.

TThis half term in Year 1 we have had great fun learning to retell the story of We're Going on a Bear Hunt. The children were fantastic at this- recalling lots of vocabulary and using expression really effectively. We went on to write a shortened version in which the family went for a walk, reached a river which they needed to 'splash splosh' through, met a bear and ran home! The children composed and wrote their own sentences for each section of the story, making sure that now we are writing more we are still keeping an eye on our letter formation and use of finger spaces so that we can read our writing back easily! Finally, we wrote our own versions of the story- in which the families meet a new obstacle of the children's choice. It was lovely to see them draw upon our learning from last half term, when we read the poem The Sound Collector by Roger McGough. The children were so inventive when describing their new obstacles and deciding what sound would be made as the family went through them.





In Maths we have been building upon our knowledge of number from Reception to solve addition and subtraction problems. Being able to quickly recognise numbers of objects, show them with our fingers and recall number bonds has really helped us to move forward and take on these new challenges. We still often use objects to help us with our Maths learning but we're also now using pictures and the facts that we know to help us too. Practising our number formation is helping us to record number sentences using plus, minus and 'equal to' signs.
