This half term is always a busy one for learning across the school. Pre-School have been exploring rhythm and rhyme, learning to recognise words that sound alike. Reception is in full swing with their work on Traditional Tales, including Jack and the Beanstalk and The Three Little Pigs. Year 1 have been investigating different materials and discovering which materials are best suited to particular jobs. Year 2 have been learning about significant explorers in History, including Matthew Henson.

Last week, a group of parents generously gave their time to help improve our school grounds by cutting back trees and tidying some of our outdoor areas. As a small school with a small staff team, we are not always able to complete these sorts of jobs, so a huge thank you to the parents who supported us! 
Next week we will be taking part in Children's Mental Health Week and Safer Internet Day. We look forward to sharing with you what we have learned.

### Prayer


Dear God,
