Classroom Focus

YEAR TWO

Year Two have had quite the musical half-term in the lead up to Christmas which has inspired lots of the learning we have been doing. In November we took a trip to St. Catherine's to take part in 'The Big Sing' with some other schools, where the children got to learn and perform lots of new and exciting songs. This has supported their writing as they have been using this trip as a focus to base their recount writing on, exploring writing in chronological order and time related sentence starters.



Throughout the term we have been exploring the theme of giving in Christianity, specifically at Christmas time linking to the Christmas story and looking at different ways that we can give to others.

Linking to one of the school values, Koinonia, this week we took a trip to Blunden Court to perform some of our Nativity songs and Christmas carols to the residents and local people at the day centre, as a way of reaching out and practising the important act of giving at this special time of year. The children sang beautifully and our audience enjoyed singing along too.



In maths we have been learning all about shape, developing on our knowledge from year one by looking at the names and characteristics of both 2-D and 3-D shapes. This has linked to the learning we have been doing in Art and Design, looking at the artist Paul Klee and the Cubism movement, exploring how shape is used in artwork. The children have had a go at recreating their own images exploring shape, cubism and colour - they have produced some really fantastic pieces!
